

## **ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

### **General Notice**

The town of Hermosa (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following projects:

#### **Contract No. 111925.01C.01: Hermosa Water Sources Upgrades-Part 1, Wells**

Sealed bids for the construction of the Projects will be received at the Town of Hermosa office located at 230 Main Street, Hermosa SD 57744 until **12:00 P.M.** local time **on April 24, 2026**. At that time the Bids will be publicly opened and read.

**Contract No. 111925.01C.01:** Contractor is responsible to furnishing materials, equipment, labor, and performing all work detailed in the HERMOSA WATER METER HOUSE IMPROVEMENTS Plan and Specifications, including but not limited to Construction of a water use system to appropriate 463 acre-feet of water annually at a maximum pump rate of 0.96 cubic feet of water per second from one well to be completed into the Madison Aquifer, 2 New pumps with controls for two existing wells, new check valves, drop pipe and removal of old control boxes. This project also includes conduit, soil erosion control and grade restoration work as well as items listed in the bid schedule. All work shall be performed in accordance with the City of Rapid City Specifications for Public Works Construction, 2022 Edition. The successful bidder shall provide all materials, labor, equipment, and incidental items necessary to complete the work per the contract documents.

### **Obtaining the Bidding Documents**

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is: Town of Hermosa, 230 Main Street, Hermosa SD 57744.

Prospective Bidders may obtain or examine the Bidding Documents for each contract at the Town Office on Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 A.M. – 5:00 P.M by appointment only. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Bidders must obtain bidding documents from the Issuing Office to be eligible to bid. All Contracts are presented in a single set of Contract Drawings and a single Project Manual.

**Printed** copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office by in-person pick-up at Town Offices at the hours indicated above, or mail-delivery upon confirmation of payment. One printed copy of the plans and specifications, without charge, to each contractor resident in South Dakota who intends, in good faith, to bid upon the public improvement will be provided by the Issuing Office. All other bidders can obtain

printed copies by paying a non-refundable cost of printed Bidding Documents of \$120.00 (fee includes 4.2% SD sales tax), plus the cost for shipping, if applicable. Checks shall be payable to "Town of Hermosa". The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt.

**Electronic** versions of the Bidding documents are also available on a flash drive (as portable document format (PDF) files) for a non-refundable charge of \$10.00, excluding shipping charges.

### **Project Funding**

The Project is funded entirely with State Revolving Funds. All requirements of the SRF General Conditions shall be met.

All Contracts for work described in these Bidding Documents obligate the Contractor to be non-discriminatory in their employment practices.

There is regulation which concerns utilization of Disadvantaged/Minority Business Enterprises (DBE/MBE) and Women's Business Enterprises (WBE). The goal for MBE is 1.5% of the total dollar value of the project. The goal for WBE is 2.4% of the total dollar value of the project. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the Equal Employment Opportunity regulations in 41 CFR Part 60 - 1.4(b) and all Civil Rights laws to include 1) Age Discrimination Act of 1975, 2) Section 13 of the FWPCA Amendments of 1972, 3) Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and 4) Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with Public Law 115-232 Prohibition of Certain Communication Technologies.

Davis-Bacon and Related Acts wages apply to this project in its entirety. All provisions relative to those acts must be met. Wage rate determinations for the project have been included in Instructions to Bidders Sec 2.23.

The low, responsive bidder will be required to certify to compliance with the American Iron and Steel provision of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014. This certification form may be found on page AIS-21 and 22 of the State Revolving Fund (SRF) General Conditions and must be included in the bid proposal.

Please be advised that waivers or exemptions from the American Iron and Steel provision that cite International Trade Agreements DO NOT comply with the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 as it applies to the SRF programs. Claims from suppliers that the American Iron and Steel provision does not apply to certain products based on the International Trade Agreement exemptions of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 will not be accepted.

### **Pre-bid Conference**

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at **2:00 p.m.** local time on, **April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026** at the Town of Hermosa South Hill Water Meter house, 550 Main Street, Hermosa, SD 57744. Attendance at a pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.
