

Notice from the Board President:

This is the guidance provided by our certified water system operator under his authority, with full support from SD DANR.

As of approximately noon yesterday, a plan was implemented that allowed us to isolate the leaking tank from the water supply. This action restored the pressure across town.

More importantly, it radically increased the amount of water available to the Town. We are now producing more than we need, especially overnight.

AS such water restrictions are being dialed back.

except during the following peak use hours:

6 am - 9 am

5 pm - 9 pm

In home domestic waster uses are fully restored, so feel free to do laundry etc.

Additionally, **hand watering** of gardens and lawns is now permitted.

Our small underground tank is on track for samples to be taken. If passed, that tank will be brought online. That is expected to occur within 3 days.

There is a team arriving shortly to clean the skinny tank, which will begin a process to bring it online that will take approximately 4 days.

There is a team scheduled to repair the leaking tank the first week in August.

The contingency plan finalized and approved last night should fully restore our capacity to 449,000 gallons by mid August. This will put us in a very good position.

Thank you to our customers for their patience while we navigate this situation during these difficult circumstances.

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
